THE PROBLEM

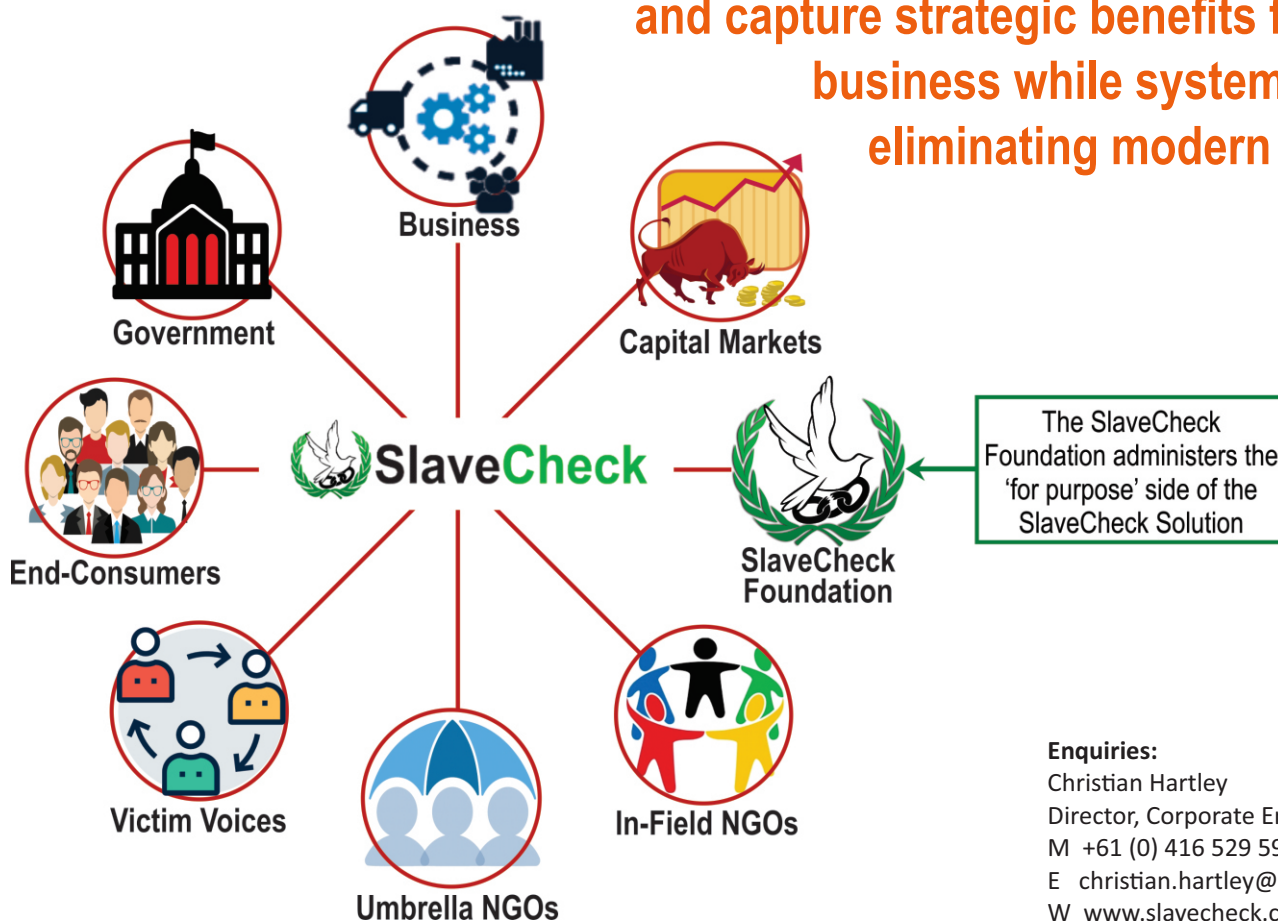

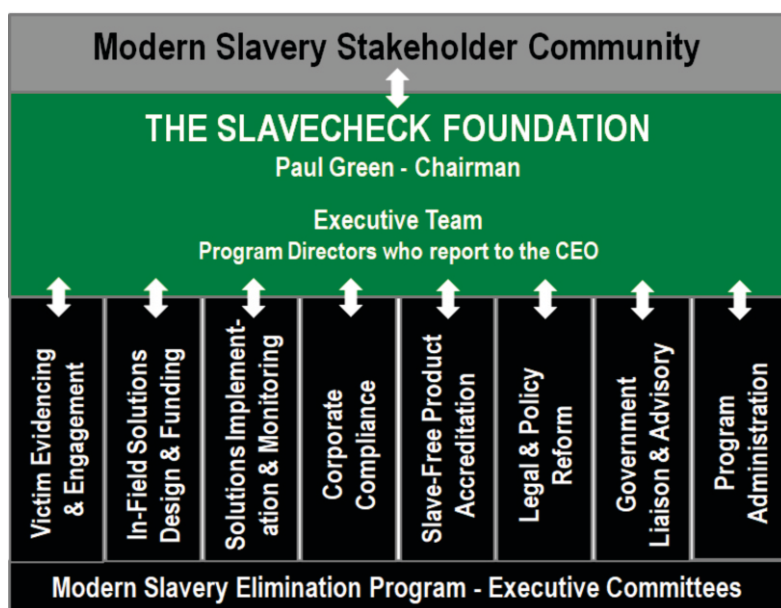
Revenue earned from reporting entities using SlaveCheck's Business Compliance Platform to achieve guaranteed compliance with anti-slavery legislation.
